### Edmodo Code of Conduct

1. All posts will use correct grammar, spelling, and punctuation.
2. Baby Bengal Behavior is expected at all times.
  - a. Your posts will be SAFE: No personally identifying information will be included in your posts. Only first names and, if necessary, last initials. Do not upload pictures for your avatar; only use the options available from Edmodo.
  - b. Your posts will be RESPONSIBLE: Edmodo is an extension of our classroom. I expect purposeful, AIG-quality posts at all times.
  - c. Your posts will be RESPECTFUL: When you are making posts (and just living life in general): Seek first to understand, then to be understood. If you disagree with or question the post of another, it is perfectly fine to express your own thoughts as long as you do it in a respectful manner.
3. Edmodo may not be used as an excuse for not doing other assignments or tasks at school or at home.

If you do not follow our Code of Conduct:
